## **TC-UPDATE (02/08)**

Raytheon

The following updates reflect changes to various provisions and clauses of U.S. Government acquisition regulations, including the Federal Acquisition Regulations ("FAR") and the Department of Defense FAR Supplement ("DFARS"). By this reference, said updates are incorporated in and made an integral part of the General Terms and Conditions (TC) documents identified below.

Government Property Installation Services 52.245-2 (JUNE 2007) (Applicable if Purchase Order is a service contract to be performed on a Government installation when Governmentfurnished property will be provided for initial provisioning only and the Government is not responsible for repair or replacement.) (This clause is added only as to Purchase Orders under prime contracts entered into after June 13, 2007.)

    - Display of Hotline Poster(s) (DEC 2007) (This clause is added only to Purchase Orders under prime contracts entered into after December 23, 2007, except Purchase Orders for the acquisition of commercial items or where performance will be entirely outside the United States.)
