

## General Terms and Conditions of Purchase – Supplement 3 National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) Supplement to the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) TC-NASA (1/09)

- A. The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) supplement to the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR), known as the NASA FAR Supplement (NFS), applies to all Purchase Orders for the acquisition of materials, products or services for use in connection with a U.S. Government NASA contract or higher-tier subcontract. For all such Purchase Orders, in addition to the FAR clauses set forth in TC-001, General Terms and Conditions of Purchase and TC-002, General Terms and Conditions of Purchase - Supplement 1, the following NFS clauses shall apply as required by the terms of the prime contract or higher-tier subcontract or by operation of law or regulation. By this reference, the NFS clauses listed below are incorporated herein as if fully set forth in this document. By acknowledging an offer to Buyer, Seller certifies its compliance with the following clauses and that Seller is, therefore, eligible for award. The effective date of each NFS clause shall correspond to the effective date of the clause in Buyer's prime contract or higher-tier subcontract under which the Purchase Order is issued.
- B. NFS clauses often supplement or amend corresponding FAR clauses. In the event of a conflict between an NFS clause and any FAR clause set forth in TC-001 or TC-002, the NFS clause shall control.
- C. In all of the NFS clauses herein, the terms "Government", "Contracting Officer" and "contractor" shall be revised to suitably identify the contracting parties under the Purchase Order and effect the proper intent of the provision, except where further clarified or modified below. The term "Subcontractor", however, shall mean "Seller's Subcontractor" under the Purchase Order.
- D. With respect to any FAR and NFS clauses incorporated into the Purchase Order that relate to rights in noncommercial technical data, noncommercial computer software and noncommercial computer software documentation, Seller grants to Buyer the right to use, disclose, modify, combine, integrate or make derivative works of any noncommercial technical data, noncommercial computer software and/or noncommercial computer software documentation delivered under the Purchase Order to the extent necessary, and for such period as is required, for Buyer to complete its performance under Buyer's U.S. Government programs.
- E. The following NFS clauses are applicable to ALL Purchase Orders unless otherwise indicated:
