*OASIS+ is a government-wide, Best-in-Class contract vehicle for complex professional services on a global basis.*

## BENEFITS

- Single solution for complex requirements

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- No contract ceiling

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- Supports both FAR Part 16.505 and commercial FAR Part 12 acquisition

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- Supports all contract types (cost reimbursable, fixed price, T&M)

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- Supports classified and unclassified, CONUS and OCONUS requirements

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- Fast, streamlined procurement

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- Ordering contracting officer controls terms, requirements, evaluation, and award

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- GSA Assisted Acquisition Service available to support, including free scope review

## Scope

The objective of this contract is to provide Government agencies with total integrated solutions for a multitude of services-based requirements on a global basis. These services requirements may call for solutions that cross multiple disciplines, include ancillary support, may be commercial or non-commercial, using a variety of contract types.

OASIS+ is available for use by all Federal agencies, and is organized by domains.

RTX awarded domains include the following scope areas:

**Technical & Engineering**  
Application of physical laws and principles of engineering in the design; development, and utilization of machines, materials, instruments, processes, and systems.

### Research & Development

Includes any requirements in support of R&D activities.

### Intelligence Services

Focuses on Command, Control, Communications, Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance mission requirements.

### Enterprise Solutions

Requirements that are large-dollar, wide-reaching (e.g., across agencies) and highly complex.

### Logistics

Comprehensive logistics solutions, including planning, designing, implementing, or operating systems or facilities for the movement of supplies, equipment or people.

### Facilities

Services required to maintain and operate buildings, utilities infrastructure, and real property assets and equipment.

<b>Host agency</b>	General Services Administration (GSA)
<b>Procuring agency</b>	Any federal government agency, with delegation of procurement authority from GSA
<b>Prime contractor</b>	RTX Corporation (Raytheon Company); managed by RTX Contract Vehicle Center (CVC)
<b>Customers</b>	Any federal government agency, with user fee of 0.15%
<b>Ceiling</b>	None. Task orders and contract vehicle have no dollar limit
<b>Period of Performance</b>	December 17, 2024 through December 16, 2034
<b>Scope of work</b>	Professional service disciplines integrated to provide a total solution to agency needs. Scope also allows ancillary services and material necessary to complete a total solution
<b>Terms</b>	Pre-negotiated clauses in basic contract. Unique terms can be added at task order level
<b>Bidding rates</b>	Forward pricing rates, unless sole-source T&M/LH proposal (labor rates on contract)
<b>Appropriation</b>	No restrictions. The type of funds must be appropriate for the scope of work

## Ordering process

<b>Acquisition Planning</b>	The agency end-user conducts standard acquisition planning activity and chooses between two acquisition methods: assisted or direct. End-users can utilize GSA Assisted Acquisition Services to place orders, or obtain a Delegation of Procurement Authority (DPA) to place Direct Orders.
<b>Define Requirements</b>	The agency end-user defines requirements for the Task Order Request (TOR) and builds solicitation using FAR Part 16.505 or FAR Part 12.
<b>Release Solicitation</b>	All OASIS+ prime contractors are provided fair opportunity to TORs on their domain(s).
<b>Evaluate Proposals</b>	Proposals (oral and/or written) are evaluated by end-user agency and GSA, if applicable.
<b>Award Task Order</b>	Task Order is issued to the “best value” contractor.
