Statutory Authority: Conn. Gen. Stat. §12-409a.

Direct Payment Permit: The permittee named above is authorized in accordance with Conn. Gen. Stat. §12-409a, to use the direct payment method to remit sales and use taxes to the State of Connecticut. This permit is valid **only** for the permittee named above. This permit is null and void if there is any change in ownership.

Purchases Not Allowed With the Direct Payment Permit:

- Tangible personal property incorporated in **new** construction to real property;
- Meals or lodging;
- Motor vehicles, vessels, aircraft, and snowmobiles;
- Telecommunications services;
- Utilities (gas, electricity, and heating fuel);
- Purchases made with Procurement Cards (P-cards); **and**
- Tangible personal property consumed or incorporated in the installation, maintenance, and repair of utility mains, lines, poles, pipes, and other facilities located within a public right-of-way.

Notice to Retailers: The direct payment permit holder **must** purchase, lease, or rent all tangible personal property and services without paying Connecticut sales and use tax to the retailer except for purchases listed above that are not allowed with the direct payment permit. Maintain this permit, attached documents, and bills or invoices to the purchaser for at least six years from the date when the items or services were purchased. The bills, invoices, or records covering the purchases made under this permit must be appropriately marked to indicate that untaxed purchases were made. The words "Purchased with Direct Payment Permit" satisfy this requirement.

Retailers may verify a valid direct payment permit by accessing the DRS Web site at www.ct.gov/DRS

No Transfer or Assignment of This Permit: This permit may not be transferred or assigned. This permit is valid from the effective date until revoked by the Department of Revenue Services (DRS) or surrender of the permit by the permit holder.

Misuse of This Permit: Misuse of this permit may result in the revocation of this permit by DRS. DRS will impose penalties for misuse of this permit.
