During his career at Collins, Jasper effectively transitioned commercial aerospace technologies to the defense sector. He led one of the industry's first programs to fully integrate commercial Communications, Navigation and Surveillance/Air Traffic Management (CNS/ATM) capability and interoperability into a military aircraft fleet. He also led the integration of RTX's connected battlespace solutions strategic focus area. His leadership of this critical growth strategy for the company helped customers across the service branches execute on their vision for multi-domain operations in a contested battlefield environment.
