



Updates to the April 2022 version of the RTX Flowdown of U.S. Government Contract Clauses

January 2023

The following updates shall be incorporated in, and made an integral part of, the Raytheon Technologies Corporation Flowdown of U.S. Government Contract Clauses Under U.S. Government Contracts.

Commercial Products and Commercial Services Acquisitions:

A. THE FOLLOWING FAR CLAUSES ARE APPLICABLE TO ORDERS FOR COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS AND COMMERCIAL SERVICES UNDER ALL GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS:

1. The following clauses are **MODIFIED**:

- **52.204-25** "Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment" (Excluding paragraph (b)(2).)
- **52.219-8** "Utilization of Small Business Concerns" (Deviation 2023-O0002, Revision 1) (Applicable to Orders that offer further subcontracting opportunities.)
- **52.222-55** "Minimum Wages for Contractor Workers Under Executive Order 14026" (Applicable to Orders, that are subject to the Service Contract Labor Standards statute or the Wage Rate Requirements (Construction) statute and are to be performed in whole or in part in the United States.)

B. THE FOLLOWING DFARS CLAUSES ARE APPLICABLE TO ORDERS FOR COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS AND COMMERCIAL SERVICES UNDER DoD CONTRACTS:

1. As a result of the DFARS Final Rule, the following clauses are **ADDED**:

- **252.225-7056** "Prohibition Regarding Business Operations with the Maduro Regime"

- **252.225-7060** “Prohibition on Certain Procurements from the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region” (Applicable to Orders for products utilizing funds appropriated or otherwise made available for fiscal year 2022.)

Federal Agency Acquisitions:

A. APPLICABLE TO ORDERS WITHOUT REGARD TO DOLLAR VALUE:

1. The following clauses are **MODIFIED**:

- **52.204-25** “Prohibition on Contracting for Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment” (Excluding paragraph (b)(2).)
- **52.219-8** “Utilization of Small Business Concerns” (Deviation 2023-O0002, Revision 1) (Applicable to Orders that offer further subcontracting opportunities.)
- **52.222-55** “Minimum Wages for Contractor Workers Under Executive Order 14026” (Applicable to Orders, that are subject to the Service Contract Labor Standards statute or the Wage Rate Requirements (Construction) statute and are to be performed in whole or in part in the United States.)

DoD Acquisitions:

A. APPLICABLE TO ALL ORDERS WITHOUT REGARD TO DOLLAR VALUE:

1. As a result of the DFARS Final Rule, the following clauses are **ADDED**:

- **252.225-7056** “Prohibition Regarding Business Operations with the Maduro Regime”
- **252.225-7060** “Prohibition on Certain Procurements from the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region” (Applicable to Orders for products utilizing funds appropriated or otherwise made available for fiscal year 2022.)

E. OTHER CLAUSES AS APPLICABLE

1. As a result of the DFARS Interim Rule, the following clause is **ADDED**:

- **252.225-7058** “Postaward Disclosure of Employment of Individuals Who Work in the People’s Republic of China” (Applicable to Orders having a value over \$5,000,000, but excluding Orders for commercial products and commercial services, and when incorporated into the Prime Contract) (“Government” means “Buyer” and “Contracting Officer” means “Buyer’s Purchasing Representative”. Disclosures should be made directly to Buyer’s Purchasing Representative.)
